- A Statutory Declaration certifying the candidate is currently studying at the required standard from her current music teacher. For example, the candidate must be able to substantiate their ability to undertake and pass the examination level at the time of application or that they are studying at a higher level than that required for minimum entry.
- A reference from your daughter's current music teacher, including their contact details.
- Reports or certificates from any competitions, eisteddfods or performances undertaken by the candidate.

Successful shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an in-person audition performing 1-2 works of their choosing. Applicants will be allocated an audition time based on their chief instrument. Applicants will be notified of audition time via email.
